



BRITISH PATHÉ *Education*

British Pathé is considered to be the finest film and newsreel archive in the world, spanning from 1896 to 1976 and containing over 90,000 individual film items and 12 million stills.

The archive covers an enormous range of subjects including modern British and world history, news, fashion, sport, entertainment, travel, warfare and 20th Century social history.

Many schools already have access to British Pathé and consider it to be an invaluable and engaging interactive resource, providing teachers and pupils with a highly-supportive cross-curricular learning, teaching and research aid.

Now this archive is available to all schools in the UK through a special education subscription.

Schools who subscribe have immediate access to the following additional features:

- Unlimited downloads of British Pathé films and stills (free of Copyright notice) for use by teachers and pupils, allowing the contextualisation of Pathé materials within classroom coursework or student projects.
- The right to publish downloaded Pathé materials on Secure School Learning Platforms (SLPs). Teachers, pupils and parents can view Pathé materials on off-school sites, including home viewing. Pathé materials can be published in their original form, contextualised with support content created by the teacher or pupil, or even edited within a pupil film project.
- Grouping together Pathé films and stills into personalised LearnSpaces. Teachers can create a collection of relevant materials for view-

ing at a later stage, either at home via an SLP or as part of a classroom project. The teacher is also able to write notes next to each of the Learnspaces.

- Access and search, via the British Pathé website, all curriculum-tagged LearnSpaces created by teachers and pupils from other subscribing schools. This allows the user to search for LearnSpaces by Key Stage, Subject and Topic. British Pathé has commissioned over 200 LearnSpaces based on the UK curriculum, created by teachers for teachers.
- The ability to view the British Pathé website free of all advertising, including pre-roll video adverts and display adverts.
- The ability to access the British Pathé website via the secure JANet Network, allowing access via IP recognition and therefore not requiring a log-in. All teachers and pupils of subscribing schools will simply go on the British Pathé website and immediately have access to the additional unlimited download and LearnSpace features and view the website free of all advertising. For schools not linked to the JANet Network a simple log-in is required.

Existing Education Subscriptions:

Many state schools in the UK already have access to free British Pathé downloads under agreements with their Regional Broadband Consortium or Local Authority.
